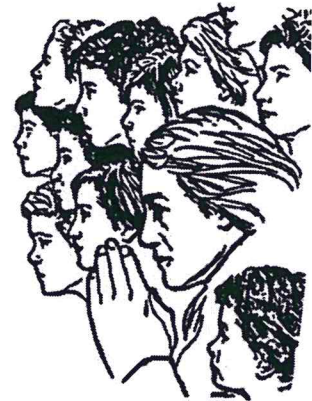
Our Father who art in heaven,
