We will not pressurize you although any discussions about faith and the spiritual life can be challenging.

We will give you the opportunity to find out more about Jesus and the Christian life.

We will do this all—gently!

What will we ask of you

We will ask nothing of you unless you want to continue to explore getting to know Jesus.

If you want to get to know Jesus we will invite you to join with this Christian family at one of our main services. If our 'style' of worship doesn't suit you we will be pleased to advise you where you may feel more at home and introduce you to one of their Ministers.

We will ask you to ask us questions - and to give us honest answers.

If you want to know more we will ask you to meet with one of the Ministry team at the Abbey or at St. Peter's.

If you want to join this Christian fellowship we will not condemn your past.
