## HOW TO SPONSOR HIM

If you want to donate some money to sponsor Nigel in this challenge, there are a number of ways to do it. Whatever you feel able to give will help us move towards our appeal target. But if you want to link your payment to Nigel's Challenge of 990 cycling miles, remember 1p per mile = £9.90, 10p per mile = £99 and £1 per mile is £990! And there are four recitals en route, with approximately 4 hours of playing time

To donate now:

Tax payers can gift aid their donations increasing the value of the money donation by 25%. Please mark your envelope Abbey Organ Fund appeal
- Or you can make an electronic payment into that account, and pop the form to the Treasurer at the above address
- Cash can also be donated, but please place in an envelope clearly marked Abbey Organ Appeal Fund appeal, and also enclose the form overleaf
